

## Terms and Conditions

1. The MR.D.I.Y. 'Belanja & Menang' Contest commences on 1 November 2021 and closes on 31 December 2021 ("Contest Period"). MR.DIY Group (M) Berhad ("Organiser") reserves the right to shorten or extend the Contest Period without prior notice. All entries received outside the Contest Period shall be automatically disqualified. The Contest will run for eight (8) Contest Weeks as follows:
  - a. Contest Week 1: 01 November 2021 – 12 November 2021;
  - b. Contest Week 2: 13 November 2021 – 19 November 2021;
  - c. Contest Week 3: 20 November 2021 – 26 November 2021;
  - d. Contest Week 4: 27 November 2021 – 03 December 2021;
  - e. Contest Week 5: 04 December 2021 – 10 December 2021;
  - f. Contest Week 6: 11 December 2021 – 17 December 2021;
  - g. Contest Week 7: 18 December 2021 – 24 December 2021;
  - h. Contest Week 8: 25 December 2021 – 31 December 2021.
2. This Contest is open to all citizens and permanent residents of Malaysia above 18 years of age (as at 1 November 2021) except the employees and immediate families of the Organiser, including its affiliated and/or related companies, distributors, dealers, advertising and promotion agencies.
3. To participate in the Contest:
  - a. Participants must spend within the Contest Period:
    - i. At any MR.D.I.Y. or MRTOY outlet: RM40.00 and above in a single receipt; OR
    - ii. At MR.D.I.Y. online shop ([www.mrdiy.com.my/](http://www.mrdiy.com.my/)): RM40.00 and above in a single receipt, excluding delivery fee; OR
    - iii. At any MRDOLLAR outlet: RM30.00 and above in a single receipt.
  - b. Scan the QR code or log in to <https://promo.mrdiy.com/my/belanja-menang/>.
  - c. Complete the online form by answering the question, filling in all the empty fields and click on submit.
  - d. Retain original single receipt dated within Contest Period that matches the online entry as proof of purchase.
  - e. Participants may send as many entries as they wish BUT each entry must be accompanied with the required details and a different receipt for each entry.
  - f. Participants are not allowed to submit/send more than one (1) entry with the same receipt to the Organiser.
  - g. Each Contest day during the Contest Period, the Contest begins at 12:00am and ends at 11:59pm.
  - h. The Organiser will not reimburse the participant for any charges incurred in submitting the entries, if any.
4. Selection of winners:
  - a. Grand Prize x 1: The eligible Grand Prize winner will be determined by the total number of qualified entries received during the Contest Period divided by 2. For example, if the total number of qualified entries received is 34,225, then this number will be divided by 2 and rounded to the nearest lower whole number which is 17,112. Hence the 17,112<sup>th</sup> qualified entry will be shortlisted and stand to win the Grand Prize. In the event the shortlisted entry is

disqualified, the next eligible earlier entry received will be the replacement winner, for example, the replacement winner for the 17,112<sup>th</sup> qualified entry is the 17,111<sup>th</sup> qualified entry.

- b. First Prize x 2: The eligible First Prize winners will be determined by the total number of qualified entries received during the Contest Period divided by 2.5. For example, if the total number of qualified entries received is 34,225, then this number will be divided by 2.5 and rounded to the nearest lower whole number which is 13,690. Hence the 13,690<sup>th</sup> and 27,380<sup>th</sup> qualified entries will be shortlisted and stand to win a First Prize each. In the event the shortlisted entry is disqualified, the next eligible earlier entry received will be the replacement winner, for example, the replacement winner for the 13,690<sup>th</sup> qualified entry is the 13,689<sup>th</sup> qualified entry.
- c. Second Prize x 3: The eligible Second Prize winners will be determined by the total number of qualified entries received during the Contest Period divided by 3.5. For example, if the total number of qualified entries received is 34,225, then this number will be divided by 3.5 and rounded to the nearest lower whole number which is 9,778. Hence the 9,778<sup>th</sup>, 19,556<sup>th</sup> and 29,334<sup>th</sup> qualified entries will be shortlisted and stand to win a Second Prize each. In the event the shortlisted entry is disqualified, the next eligible earlier entry received will be the replacement winner, for example, the replacement winner for the 9,778<sup>th</sup> qualified entry is the 9,777<sup>th</sup> qualified entry.
- d. Third Prize x 5: The eligible Third Prize winners will be determined by the total number of qualified entries received during the Contest Period divided by 5.5. For example, if the total number of qualified entries received is 34,225, then this number will be divided by 5.5 and rounded to the nearest lower whole number which is 6,222. Hence the 6,222<sup>nd</sup>, 12,444<sup>th</sup>, 18,666<sup>th</sup> qualified entries and so on will be shortlisted and stand to win a Third Prize each. In the event the shortlisted entry is disqualified, the next eligible earlier entry received will be the replacement winner, for example, the replacement winner for the 6,222<sup>nd</sup> qualified entry is the 6,221<sup>st</sup> qualified entry.
- e. Fourth Prize x 8: The eligible Fourth Prize winners will be determined by the total number of qualified entries received during the Contest Period divided by 8.5. For example, if the total number of qualified entries received is 34,225, then this number will be divided by 8.5 and rounded to the nearest lower whole number which is 4,026. Hence the 4,026<sup>th</sup>, 8,052<sup>nd</sup>, 12,078<sup>th</sup> qualified entries and so on will be shortlisted and stand to win a Fourth Prize each. In the event the shortlisted entry is disqualified, the next eligible earlier entry received will be the replacement winner, for example, the replacement winner for the 4,026<sup>th</sup> qualified entry is the 4,025<sup>th</sup> qualified entry.
- f. Weekly Prize x 125 Winners x 8 Contest Weeks: The eligible Weekly Prize winners will be determined by the total number of qualified entries received during the Contest Week divided by 125.5. For example, if the total number of qualified entries received is 4,393, then this number will be divided by 125.5 and rounded to the nearest lower whole number which is 35. Hence the 35<sup>th</sup>, 70<sup>th</sup>, 105<sup>th</sup> qualified entries and so on will be shortlisted and stand to win a Weekly Prize each for the Contest Week. In the event the shortlisted entry is disqualified, the next eligible earlier entry received will be the replacement winner, for example, the replacement winner for the 35<sup>th</sup> qualified entry is the 34<sup>th</sup> qualified entry.
- g. The eligible prize winners will be contacted via telephone and may be required to correctly answer a question before being declared a winner.

Should the first attempt to contact the eligible winner fail, for example, no reply, telephone number not in service or no connection, etc, another two (2) attempts will be made within the next twenty four (24) hours of the first telephone call. Where such further attempts are unsuccessful, the Organiser reserves the right to disqualify the eligible winner and thereafter select the next qualified participant. The Organiser will not be held liable in the event the winners cannot be contacted for whatever reasons. In the event the eligible winner fails to correctly answer the simple question, the Organiser reserves the right to disqualify the eligible winner and find another eligible winner as replacement.

- h. The eligible prize winners may be required to submit by Pos Laju/courier all the original printed receipts dated within the Contest Period that match all the entries as well as a copy of their NRIC within three (3) working days from the date of notification as proof of purchase. Failing which, the Organiser reserves the right to disqualify the eligible winner.
- i. Only original and valid printed receipts will be accepted. Any receipt that is illegible, mutilated, altered, duplicated, tampered with, not obtained legitimately, contains printing typographical, mechanical or other errors or the printing is unclear or does not contain the required information is invalid and will not be accepted. The Organiser reserves the sole discretion and rights to disqualify such invalid receipts.
